

ORDINANCE NO. 998

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO AMENDING SECTIONS 5.08.120 AND 5.08.130 BY DELETING MEMORIAL DAY, THANKSGIVING; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALER CLAUSE; SEVERABILITY CLAUSE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1: That Section 5.08.120 is amended as follows:

5.08.120 Premises--Prohibited hours of operation: No liquor shall be sold, offered for sale, given away or consumed upon any licensed premises during the following hours:

A. ~~Memorial Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day from two a.m. to ten a.m. the following day.~~

B. On any other day between two a.m. and ten a.m.

C. On any day of general or primary election until after the time when the polls are closed.

Section 2: That Section 5.08.130 is amended as follows:

5.08.130 Premises--Presence of persons prohibited when--Nonapplicability. A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, it is unlawful for any person to be present upon any licensed premises for any purposes whatsoever during the following hours:

1. ~~Memorial Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day from two a.m. to ten a.m. the following day;~~

2. On any other day between two a.m. and ten a.m.;


3. On any day of a general or primary election until after the time when the polls are closed.

Section 3: Any portions of any existing Ordinances which are in direct conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 4: If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remaining portion of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS APPROVAL, PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the day 18 of December, 1989.
