

ORDINANCE NO. 143 BY W. H. PLATT.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 116.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of Payette shall receive for his services, the sum of two hundred (\$200) dollars per year, to be paid in quarterly payments of fifty (\$50) dollars each; and each councilman shall receive for his services the sum of three (\$3) for each session he attends; Provided that no councilman shall receive or be allowed ~~any~~ compensation for attending more than two ~~meetings~~ sessions in any one month, or any compensation for any session at which he is not present for the entire session.

Section 2. The City Clerk, ~~as such clerk~~, <sup>to be</sup> ex-officio tax collector and auditor, shall receive the sum of forty (\$40) dollars per month.

Section 3. The City Treasurer shall receive for his services the sum of twenty five (\$25) dollars per annum.

Section 4. The City Marshal, other police officers and City Attorney shall receive for their services such salaries as the City Council may from time to time determine by resolution.

Section 5. The Police Judge shall receive ~~for his services~~ the same fees as Justices of the Peace for similar services.

Section 6. The City Engineer shall receive for his services the sum of One Hundred (\$100) Dollars per year, payable in quarterly payments of twenty five (\$25) dollars each.

Section 7. Ordinance Number 116 of the City of Payette entitled "An ordinance fixing the compensation of the officers of the City of Payette" is hereby repealed.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be in force and effect on and after May 1st, 1909.
