

ORDINANCE NO. 163 BY Woodward

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE "PEOPLES IRRIGATION COMPANY, LIMITED, A CORPORATION, THE RIGHT, PRIVILEGE AND AUTHORITY TO BUILD, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN WATER PIPE LINES AND WATER SYSTEMS THROUGH THE STREETS AND ALLEYS OF THAT PART OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, LYING BETWEEN ~~MAIN~~ ^{Payette} AVENUE AND COMMERCIAL STREET.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is granted to the Peoples Irrigation Company, Limited, a corporation, the right, privilege and authority to build, operate and maintain water pipe lines and water systems for the purpose of conveying ^{and distributing} water for irrigation purposes only, to its stockholders, on lands in said City of Payette, Idaho, lying between ~~Main~~ ^{Payette} Avenue and Commercial street.

Section 2. The main line and laterals of said water pipe line ~~shall be~~ and water system shall be properly constructed and maintained by said Peoples Irrigation Company, Limited, ^{not less than 2 feet} under ground and the waters therein conducted shall not be permitted to flood or in any way damage the streets and alleys of the said City. The location of the said pipe lines shall be under the control and direction of the Mayor and Council of the said City.

Section 3. The main line of said pipe line or water system shall be ~~along~~ located along the alley lying between Main Street and Ada Avenue, with lateral lines along any of the streets or alleys of said City of Payette, lying between ~~Main~~ ^{Payette} Avenue and Commercial Street.

Section 4. Said water pipe line and water system shall be so constructed as to not interfere with any other pipe, sewer conduit or other works lawfully entitled to be in any of said streets or alleys. The said Peoples Irrigation Company, Limited, shall forever save the City of Payette harmless from any damages by reason of the said pipes or water system being run in and along the said streets and alleys.
