

ORDINANCE No. 208 By Compton.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 10 and 20 AND AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 202 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1.

That Section 10 and 20 of Ordinance No. 202 of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled "An ordinance making the annual appropriation and levy for general, road and salary purposes, and special assessments for the redemption of outstanding water works, water works extension and sewer bonds and the payment of interest on the same, and a special levy for the redemption of outstanding warrants, and the payment of the accrued interest thereon.", passed by the Mayor and Council and approved by the Mayor on the fourteenth day of August, 1911, be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 2.

That Section 3 of said Ordinance No. 202 of the City of Payette, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3.

That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the road fund of the city of Payette.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTIONS 10 AND 20 AND AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 202, OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That sections 10 and 20 of ~~the~~ ordinance No. 202 of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled "An ordinance making the annual appropriation and levy for general, road, ~~water~~ and salary purposes, and special assessments for the redemption of outstanding water works, water works extension and sewer bonds and the payment of interest on the same and a special levy for the redemption of outstanding warrants and the payment of the accrued interest thereon", passed by the Mayor and Council and approved by the Mayor on the 14th day of August, 1911, be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 2. That section 3 of said ordinance No. 202 of the City of Payette, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 3 That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1911, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of ^{1- $\frac{1}{2}$ mills} ~~2000 mills~~ on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Road Fund of the City of Payette.
