ORDINANCE NO. 211 BY Burns

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 209 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AND DISPOSING OF THE ENTIRE ALLEY RUNNING ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF BLOCKS 16, 17, 18 AND 19 OF GORRIE'S ADDITION TO PAYETTE, IDAHO."

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

That ordinance No. 209 of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled "~~and~~ An ordinance closing and disposing of the entire alley running along the East side of Blocks 16, 17, 18 and 19 of Gorrie's Addition to Payette, Idaho" passed by the Mayor and Council and approved by the Mayor of said City on the 4th day of October, 1911, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

~~That~~ Section 1. That the alley running along the east side of Blocks 16, 17, 18 and 19 of Gorrie's Addition to Payette, Idaho, beginning at the North-east corner of Block 19 of said Gorrie's Addition, thence East to the West line of the East Half of the South-west quarter of the North-west quarter of Section 34, Township 9 North, Range 5 West of the Boise Meridian, in Canyon County, Idaho; thence South along said West line to a point East of the South-east corner of said Block 16 of said Addition; thence West to the South-east corner of said Block 16; thence North along the East lines of said Blocks 16, 17, 18 and 19 to the place of beginning, except therefrom the intersections of said alley with First Avenue North, Second Avenue North and Third Avenue North and the alleys running through said blocks 16, 17 and 18 in an East and West direction.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper.

Passed and approved this 11<sup>th</sup> day of Dec, 1911.
