

ORDINANCE NO. 218 BY Woodward

AN ORDINANCE GIVING NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CREATE A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT SPRINKLING DISTRICT IN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ DESCRIBING SAID DISTRICT, PROVIDING THAT THE EXPENSES AND COSTS OF SAID IMPROVEMENT SHALL BE ASSESSED AND CHARGED AGAINST THE PROPERTY FRONTING ON THE STREETS WITHIN SAID DISTRICT AND PROVIDING A TIME WITHIN WHICH PROTESTS AGAINST THE CONSTRUCTION OF AND THE MAKING OF SAID IMPROVEMENT MAY BE MADE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Sec. 1. That the property owners of the proposed improvement district hereinafter described, are hereby notified that it is the intention of the City of Payette to improve the property in the district hereinafter mentioned by applying water to the same during the dry or dusty season of the year, or sprinkling the same; the following is a description of the boundaries of the said district to-wit: All of the streets and avenues lying within the boundaries of the said City of Payette, consisting of the following streets, avenues and parts of streets and avenues, to-wit: River Street, Second Street, Fourth Street; Fifth Street, Sixth Street, Seventh Street, Eighth Street, Ninth Street, Tenth Street, Eleventh Street, Twelfth Street, Thirteenth Street, Fourteenth Street, Fifteenth Street, Sixteenth Street, Eighteenth Street, Nineteenth Street and Twentieth Street, and the following named avenues First Avenue North, Second Avenue North, Third Avenue North, Fourth Avenue North, Fifth Avenue North, Sixth Avenue North, Seventh Avenue North and Eight Avenue North; First Avenue South, Second Avenue South, Third Avenue South and Sixth Avenue South.

Section 2. That said proposed improvement shall be made by sprinkling the surface of the said streets and avenues ^{with water} during the dry and dusty season of the year, sufficient to prevent the same from becoming dusty, the same to ^{be} applied from sprinklers of the ordinary type used for sprinkling purpose.

Section 3. The cost and expense of said improvement will be taxed and assessed against all the abutting property on the said streets and parts of streets, lots and parcels of land located and being in said proposed district; and the estimated expenses of springling said proposed district ~~shall~~ will be 09 Cents per front foot of the frontage of said property on the various streets and avenues in said proposed district, ^{and in proportion to the benefits received} Provided that the improvement in the space formed by the intersection of one street or avenue with another street or avenue, or by one street ~~or~~ avenue terminating in another street or avenue shall be born and paid by the City of Payette.

Section 4. Notice is hereby given to all property owners owning property abutting and contiguous to said streets and avenues that Monday, September 2nd, 1912 at the hour of 8 o'clock P. M. of said day, ^{at the City Hall} is the time and place where objections to the formation of said improvement district will be heard, and all persons having objections thereto are hereby notified to file the same with the City Clerk of said City on or before 6 o'clock P. M. of said Second Day of September.
