

ORDINANCE NO. 222 BY BURNS.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT THE CITY CLERK SHALL BE EX-OFFICIO POLICE JUDGE, AND SHALL BE THE COLLECTOR OF SPECIAL TAXES, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. The City Clerk of the City of Payette, shall be ex-officio Police Judge, and as such shall exercise the jurisdiction and perform the duties prescribed by the laws of the State of Idaho, and the ordinances of the City of Payette.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall also be the collector of taxes and all special assessments, and license fees that may be levied or may^{be} authorized to be collected by the ordinances of the City and when the same are not paid before they become delinquent, in case of special taxes or assessments, he shall certify the same to the County Tax Collector for collection as required by law. All such taxes and assessments shall be paid to the City treasurer as other city funds.

The City Clerk shall also^{be} the collector of water rentals for the City water works system, and when water users fail to pay water rentals as provided by ordinances of the City, he shall forthwith notify the water Superintendent, whose duty shall be to shut the water off as provided by the ordinances of the said City.

Section 3. This ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon the passage, approval and publication thereof in the official newspaper of the City, in all respects, except that part making the City Clerk, ex-officio Police Judge, and that part of the same shall be in force at the commencement of the fiscal year 1913-14.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances is so far as they are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE OFFICERS OF THE CITY ~~OF~~
OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 184.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. The Mayor of the City of Payette shall receive for his services as such mayor, the sum of three hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly; and each councilman shall receive for his services the sum of five dollars for each session of the council he attends; Provided that no councilman shall receive or be allowed compensation for attending more than three sessions in any one month, or any compensation for any session at which he is not present for the entire time.

Section 2. The City Clerk, as such clerk and ex-officio Police Judge and Auditor shall receive for his services the sum of one hundred dollars per month.

Section 3. The City Treasurer shall receive for his services the sum of twenty five dollars per annum, payable annually.

Section 4. The City Engineer shall receive for his services the sum of one hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly, which shall be in full compensation for all services rendered for the City of Payette.

Section ~~4~~ The City attorney shall receive for his services the sum of thirty dollars per month, payable monthly.

Section 5. The City Marshall, ^{and other police officers} shall receive such salary for their services such sums as the council may from time to time determine by resolution.

Section 6. Ordinance No. 184 of the City of Payette, entitled "An ordinance fixing the compensation of the officers of the City of Payette, Idaho, and repealing ordinances Numbers 143 and 148" and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
