

ORDINANCE No 231

An Ordinance amending Section One, of Ordinance No. 75, of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled "an Ordinance prohibiting the playing of the games of Ball and Foot-Ball, and throwing, Batting or kicking of any hand Ball, or Foot-Ball within the limits of the City of Payette, on Sundays, and fixing the bounds in the said City of Payette, within which the said games shall not be played on Sunday."

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. Any person who shall play the game of Ball, or Foot-Ball, or shall throw, bat or kick any hand ball or Foot-Ball within the limits of the City of Payette, on the first day of the week commonly called Sunday, except as hereinafter provided, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof, shall be fined in a sum of not less than Ten Dollars, nor more than One Hundred Dollars, and the costs of prosecution, and shall be committed to the jail of said City until said fine is paid, not exceeding one days confinement for each two dollars of said fine; Provided; that any of said games may be played within said City on that part of lot two, (2) in Section thirty-three, (33) Township Nine, (9) North of Range Five, (5) West of the Boise Meridian, lying west of the right of way of the Oregon Short Line Railway Company, within said City.

Section 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

*Section 3 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its <sup>passage</sup> approval and publication in the official newspaper*

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 229 granting a franchise to The Beaver River Power Company was passed and approved the 28th day of April, 1913, by the Mayor and Council of the city of Payette, Canyon county, state of Idaho, and thereafter assigned to the Idaho Power & Light Company;

AND WHEREAS, it is impossible for said assignee to comply with the provisions of Section 9 of the said franchise in so far as it requires the delivery of electrical current for use in the city of Payette on or before January 1, 1914, or the building of five miles of additional lines for the purpose of delivering current to the city of Payette;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Mayor and Council of the city of Payette, Canyon county, state of Idaho, that the said Idaho Power & Light Company, as successor of The Beaver River Power Company, may have until the 1st day of June, 1914 in which to deliver current for use in the city of Payette, or build at least five miles of line in addition to its existing line intended for use in delivering said current to the city of Payette, and that said franchise shall be considered in full force and effect until June 6, 1914, after which, unless one of the alternative conditions just suggested has been performed, the said franchise shall become voidable at the option of the City Council of Payette.
