

ORDINANCE # 233 *By Smith*

*Class 7*

An Ordinance to amend <sup>Class 7</sup> section #1 of Ordinance # 190; amending section #1, #2, # 6 and # 8, of Ordinance # 176, entitled an Ordinance for raising Revenue by placing a license on various kinds of amusements, business and professions, and requiring a license of Peddlers, hawkers, and draymen, confectionary dealers, auctioneers, bill posters and laundrymen, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof, and to repeal said original section #1 of Ordinance #190.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:  
Section #1. That <sup>Class 7</sup> section #1 of Ordinance #190 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section #1. All exhibitions of moving pictures known as auto-scope, kinetoscope, cinestograph or other like automatic or moving picture devices shall belong to and be known as entertainments of the sixth class, and ~~the~~ a license fee of \$15.00 per quarter or \$50.00 per annum in advance, shall be paid, which shall entitle the holder of said license to exhibit vaudeville, operatic, dramatic or other entertainments of like nature in connection therewith, without additional license fee.

Section #2. That said original <sup>Class 7</sup> section #1, of Ordinance #190 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section #3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
