

ORDINANCE No. 138 By Crighton

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING SEVENTH STREET, FROM THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID SEVENTH STREET, SOUTH, 300 FEET NORTH AND SOUTH, AND 100 FEET IN WIDTH; CONDEMNING AND APPROPRIATING LOT 14, OF PRESTEL TRACT OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, FOR STREET PURPOSES, AND APPOINTING APPRAISERS TO ASSESS THE INJURY AND DAMAGES TO THE OWNER OF SAID LOT 14.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That Seventh Street of said City of Payette, be, and the same is extended 300 feet south from the south side of Third Avenue South, and of a width of 100 feet through Lot 14, in Prestel Tract of said City.

Section 2. That said Lot 14, of Prestel Tract of said City of Payette, is hereby condemned and appropriated for street purposes in the opening and extending of said Seventh Street.

Section 3. That F. Crowther; Jean McDonald; P. H. Brown; Lou Soule and William Maule, of said City of Payette, be, and the same are hereby appointed Appraisers, to ~~be~~ appraise and assess the injury and damages to the owner of said lot 14, by the condemnation and appropriation of said Lot 14, for street purposes.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
