ORDINANCE NO. 272 BY Crouch

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9 OF ORDINANCE NO. 176 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR RAISING A REVENUE BY PLACING A LICENSE ON VARIOUS KINDS OF AMUSEMENTS, BUSINESS, AND PROFESSIONS AND REQUIRING A LICENSE OF PEDDLERS, HAWKERS, DRAYMEN, CONFECTIONERY DEALERS, AUCTIONEERS, BILL POSTERS AND LAUNDRYMEN AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF".

BE IT Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That Section "9" of Ordinance No. 176 of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled "An ordinance providing for raising a revenue by placing a license on various kinds of amusements, business, and professions, and requiring a license of peddlers, hawkers, draymen, confectionery dealers, auctioneers, bill posters and laundrymen, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof", be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 9. Every person, firm, association or corporation who conducts the business of running a steam laundry, or who collects clothing, materials or other goods for washing or laundry purposes, or <sup>acts</sup> as an agent for any laundry, whether located in the City of Payette or not, within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, shall pay a license fee of \$ 40<sup>00</sup> per month. And person, firm, association or corporation who acts as shipper for any goods or materials for laundry purpose, except his, their or its own shall be deemed an agent for the purpose of this ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect after its passage, approval and publication.

The city council of the city of Payette, in the state of Idaho, met in Reg. Adjourned session at the city hall in said city, on Tuesday, the 15<sup>th</sup> day of June A. D. 1915, at 8 o'clock P. M., pursuant to the rules of said council.

The mayor, Burt Venable, called the meeting to order, and upon roll call it was found that the following councilmen were present: Wm Maule, Geo. Rezac, L.W. Spaulding, H.C. Crouch, G.F. Johnson and E.W. Egan.

Thereupon, Councilman Johnson introduced an ordinance entitled:

"An Ordinance amending an ordinance entitled 'An Ordinance confirming the creation and establishment of Local Sidewalk and Curb Improvement District No. 1, in the city of Payette; approving the assessment roll for said district as filed in the office of the city clerk and confirmed by the council on the 22nd day of September, A. D. 1914, providing for the payment by installments of the costs and expenses of the improvements made in said district; providing for the issue of improvement bonds of the district; assessing the cost of the said improvements against the lots, blocks and parcels of land in said district contiguous to, fronting or abutting upon said improvements, and describing the manner for the collection and payment of said assessments;" passed and approved April 19, 1915, and numbered 267; which ordinance was thereupon read in full and is as follows:
