

ORDINANCE NO. 284 BY REZAC.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION AND LEVY FOR GENERAL, ROAD AND SALARY PURPOSES AND SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE REDEMPTION OF OUTSTANDING BONDED INDEBTEDNESS, AND THE PAYMENT OF INTEREST ON THE OUTSTANDING BONDED INDEBTEDNESS, AND THE REDEMPTION OF OUTSTANDING WARRANT INDEBTEDNESS OF SAID CITY.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That the sum of \$3500, together with all fines and moneys not otherwise appropriated, is hereby appropriated for the General Expenses of the City of Payette for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday of May, 1916.

Section 2. That the sum of \$4600 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1916, for the purpose of paying all salaries of the various officers of the said City of Payette, and the same shall constitute the salary fund for such purpose.

Section 3. That the sum of \$5000 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May 1916, for the purpose of building and keeping in repair all roads and streets within the corporate limits of the said City of Payette, and the same shall constitute the Road Fund of said City.

Section 4. That the sum of \$2600 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1916, for the purpose of lighting the streets and public thoroughfares of the said City of Payette, and the same shall constitute the Street Lighting Fund of said City.

Section 5. That the sum of \$2700.⁰⁰/₁₀₀ is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1916, for the purpose of paying all interest on all general bond issued of the said City of Payette, and the same shall constitute the Bond Interest Fund of the said City.

Section 6. That the sum of \$2000 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1916, ~~and~~ for the purpose of redeeming and taking up outstanding warrants heretofore issued by the said City of of Payette, which have not been

paid for lack of funds, and the same shall constitute the warrant redemption fund of the said City.

Section 7. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1916, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the said City of Payette, the sum of .003 mills on each one dollar of the valuation of said property, and the funds realized from such levy together with all licenses and fines and all moneys not otherwise disposed of, shall be placed in the General Fund of the said City of Payette.

Section 8. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1916, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of .0038 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Salary Fund of said City.

Section 9. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1916, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of .0041 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from said levy shall be placed in the Road Fund of said City.

Section 10. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1916, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette the sum of .0022 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from said levy shall be placed in the Street Lighting Fund of said City.

Section 11. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1916, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, the sum of .0022 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from

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such levy shall be placed in the in the Bond Interest Funds of said City.

Section 12. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1916, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the said City of Payette, the sum of .0017 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Warrant Redemption Fund of the said City.
