

ORDINANCE NO. 285 BY CROUCH.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC ON THE STREETS, ALLEYS, AVENUES AND PUBLIC PLACES OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 193 AND ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. The word vehicle includes everything on wheels or runners, except baby carriages. The word horse includes domestic animals. The word driver includes the rider of wheels, the rider and driver of horses and the operator of motor vehicles.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any driver to operate or drive any vehicle within the corporate limits of the City of Payette at a greater speed than fifteen miles an hour.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any driver to operate or drive any motor vehicle upon any street unless provided with adequate brakes in good working order and an adequate horn or other device for signaling.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful for any driver to operate or drive, or have upon the streets, alleys, avenues or public places within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, between the hours of one hour after sun down and one hour before sun ~~up~~ rise, without having thereon two front lamps properly lighted and burning, and one rear lamp properly lighted and burning and displaying a red light; all of said lamps to be lighted and burning, whether said motor vehicle shall be standing or in motion, and all muffler cut outs must be kept closed.

Section 5. Any vehicle meeting another shall pass to the right, and a vehicle overtaking another shall pass to the left side of the vehicle overtaken and shall not pull over to the right until entirely clear of the vehicle so overtaken, and all vehicles must travel on the right side of the street or avenue, except when passing a vehicle overtaken.

Section 6. The driver of any vehicle within the corporate limits of the city of Payette who desires or intends to turn into an intersecting street to the left must keep to the right of the center of such intersection in the direction in which the traffic is moving; and if intending to turn to the right, such driver must turn in such direction, keeping as close to the right hand intersecting corner as safety and convenience will permit and any such driver turning around to go in the opposite direction, shall turn such vehicle to the left so as to turn in the direction in which traffic is moving on the side of the

street toward which crossing is made; and any motor vehicle left standing on any motor vehicle left standing on any street or avenue located within the fire limits of the city of Payette on which the engine shall not be left running, must be headed into and toward the curb line in the direction in which traffic is moving, at an angle of 45 degrees; provided that no motor vehicle shall be turned on 8th street between 3rd and 4th streets at an angle of forty five

~~degrees (45)~~.

Section 7. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine of not less than five nor more than one hundred dollars or imprisoned in the jail of the city of Payette for not less than three days nor more than sixty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 8. Ordinance No. 193 and all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 9. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper.
