ORDINANCE NO. 291 by E.A. Blair.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION AND LEVY FOR GENERAL, ROAD AND SALARY PURPOSES AND SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE REDEMPTION OF OUTSTANDING BONDED INDEBTEDNESS, AND THE PAYMENT OF INTEREST ON THE OUTSTANDING BONDED INDEBTEDNESS, AND THE REDEMPTION OF OUTSTANDING WARRANT INDEBTEDNESS OF SAID CITY.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. That the sum of \$5000.00, together with all fines and moneys not otherwise appropriated, is hereby appropriated for the General Expenses of the City of Payette, Idaho, for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday of May, A.D. 1917.

Section 2. That the sum of \$5115.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A.D. 1917, for the purpose of paying all salaries of the various officers in said City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the salary fund for such purpose.

Section 3. That the sum of \$5000.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May A.D. 1917, for the purpose of building and keeping in repair all roads and streets within the corporate limits of the said City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the Road Fund of said City of Payette.

Section 4. That the sum of \$3600.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May A.D. 1917, for the purpose of lighting the streets and public thoroughfares of the said City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the Street Lighting Fund of said City of Payette.

Section 5. That the sum of \$5285.00 is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A.D. 1917, for the purpose of paying all interest on all general bond issues of the said City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the Bond Interest Fund of the said City of Payette.

Section 6. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A.D. 1917, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the said City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of .0042 mills on each one dollar of the valuation of said property, and the funds realized from such levy together with all licenses and fines and all moneys not otherwise disposed of, shall be placed in the General Fund of said City of

Payette, Idaho.

Section 7. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A.D. 1917, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of .0043 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Salary Fund of the said City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 8. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May A.D. 1917, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of .004 mills on each <sup>one dollar</sup> ~~dollar~~ of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from said levy shall be placed in the Road Fund of said City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 9. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A.D. 1917, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of .003 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from said levy shall be placed in the Street Lighting Fund of said City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 10. That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May A.D. 1917, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, the sum of .0045 mills on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of such property and the funds realized from such levy shall be placed in the Bond Interest Fund of the said City of Payette, Idaho.
