

ORDINANCE NO. 306 by Musgrove

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "SECTION 6" OF ORDINANCE NO. 20 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF FIRE PLACES, CHIMNEYS AND SMOKE PIPES, TO PROVIDE FOR THE INSPECTION, SUPPRESSION, OR CLEANING OF FIRE PLACES, CHIMNEYS, SMOKE PIPES, OR ANY APPARATUS USED IN ANY BUILDING WHICH MAY BE DANGEROUS IN CAUSING, OR PROMOTING FIRES: AND COMBUSTIBLE MATERIAL, RUBBISH OR DEBRIS FOUND IN THE STREETS, ALLEYS, COMMONS, OR ENCLOSURES IN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF."

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1.

That section six of ordinance No. 20 of the city of Payette, Idaho, passed and approved the 9th day of September, 1903, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof, before the Police Judge, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars, and costs of prosecution; and in default of payment thereof, shall be imprisoned for a time not to exceed one day for every two dollars of such fine, and each day of maintaining or continuing such violation, shall be deemed a new offence, and punished accordingly.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper of the City of Payette, Idaho.
