AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "SECTION 2" OF ORDINANCE NO. 108 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 234 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE TAXING AND KILLING OF DOGS", ALSO AMENDING "SECTION 5" OF ORDINANCE NO. 108 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE TAXING AND KILLING OF DOGS".

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1.

That section two of ordinance No. 108, as amended by Ordinance No. 234 of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled "An Ordinance to provide for the Taxing and Killing of Dogs", passed and approved the 20th day of May 1908, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to issue a license to any person applying therefor, upon the payment of three dollars per head for each dog and five dollars per head for each slut or bitch, each and every year, said license to dated from the first of the fiscal year in which they are granted. Such license fee shall be due and payable on the 15th day of April of each and every year.

Section 2.

That section five of Ordinance No. 108 of the City of Payette, Idaho, passed and approved the 20th day of May, 1908, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5. Any person who shall molest, interrupt, hinder or prevent the Marshal or any public officer in the discharge of his duties herein prescribed, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, together with costs of prosecution.

Section 3.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper of the City of Payette, Idaho.
