AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS IN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, COUNTY OF PAYETTE, STATE OF IDAHO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF SAID CITY, THE FOLLOWING QUESTION, TO-WIT: SHALL THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, BE AUTHORIZED TO SELL AND CONVEY FOR NOT LESS THAN \$2,000.00 IN CASH, THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED REAL PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE SAID CITY OF PAYETTE, SITUATE IN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, COUNTY OF PAYETTE, STATE OF IDAHO, AND MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT LOT 8, BLOCK 1 OF GORRIE'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ACCORDING TO THE OFFICIAL PLAT OF SAID ADDITION NOW ON FILE AND OF RECORD IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY RECORDER, OF PAYETTE COUNTY, IDAHO.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho: Section 1. That a special election of the qualified electors of the City of Payette, Idaho, shall be held on the 22nd. day of April, A. D. 1919, for the purpose of submitting to the said electors the following question, to-wit: Shall the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, be authorized to sell and convey for not less than \$2,000.00 in cash, the following described real property belonging to the said City of Payette, situate in the City of Payette, County of Payette, State of Idaho, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Lot 8, Block 1 of Gorrie's Addition to the City of Payette, Idaho, according to the Official plat of said addition now on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder of Payette County, Idaho.

Section 2. That if a majority of the qualified electors voting at said election, vote in favor of authorizing the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, selling and conveying the property above described for a sum not less than \$2000.00 in cash, then said proposition shall be deemed to have carried, and the Mayor and City Clerk shall be authorized to make, execute and deliver a good and sufficient warranty deed on behalf of the said City of Payette, Idaho, for the due conveying of said above described property to the purchaser.

Section 3. At least ten days notice of said special election shall be given by the City Clerk of the said City of Payette, Idaho, by publication of notice thereof in the Payette Enterprise, the official newspaper of said city of Payette, published and having general circulation therein, and by posting such notice in three of the most public places within the corporate limits of the said city of Payette, Idaho, and such publication and such posting of such notice, shall be made at least 10 days before the holding of said special election; and the said election shall be conducted as provided by law, relative to the holding of special elections, for the purpose of authorizing the sale of real estate by cities of the second class, in the State of Idaho.

Section 4. The voting at said special election shall be by ballot, and said ballot shall be so prepared as to permit the voter to express his desire for or against the said selling and conveying of said property, for not less than \$2,000.00 in cash, and such ballot shall be substantially in the following form, to-wit:

Shall the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, be authorized to sell and convey for not less than \$2,000.00 in cash, the following described real property belonging to the said City of Payette, situate in the City of Payette, County of Payette, State of Idaho, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Lot 8, Block 1 of Gorrie's Addition to the City of Payette, Idaho, according to the official plat of said addition now on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder, of Payette County, Idaho, under the provisions of Ordinance No. 317 of the City of Payette, Idaho;

The choice of the elector shall be expressed by his placing a cross (X) in the appropriate circle to be provided for on said ballots. Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper.

ORDINANCE NO. 317 BY BLAIR.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, COUNTY OF PAYETTE, STATE OF IDAHO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF SAID CITY, THE FOLLOWING QUESTION, TO-WIT: SHALL THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, BE AUTHORIZED TO SELL AND CONVEY FOR NOT LESS THAN \$2,000. IN CASH, THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED REAL PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE SAID CITY OF PAYETTE, SITUATE IN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, COUNTY OF PAYETTE, STATE OF IDAHO, AND MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT: LOT 8, BLOCK 1 OF GORRIES ADDITION TO THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ACCORDING TO THE OFFICIAL PLAT OF SAID ADDITION NOW ON FILE AND OF RECORD IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY RECORDER, OF PAYETTE COUNTY, IDAHO.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette,

Idaho:

Section 1.

That a special election of the qualified electors of the City of Payette, Idaho, shall be held on the 22nd. day of April, A. D. 1919, for the purpose of submitting to the said electors the following question, to-wit: Shall the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, be authorized to sell and convey for not less than \$2,000. in cash, the following described real property belonging to the said City of Payette, situate in the City of Payette, County of Payette, State of Idaho, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Lot 8, Block 1 of Corrie's Addition to the City of Payette, Idaho, according to the official plat of said addition now on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder of Payette County, Idaho.

Section 2.

That if a majority of the qualified electors voting at said election, vote in favor of authorizing the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, selling and conveying the property above described for a sum not less than \$2,000. in cash, then said proposition shall be deemed to have carried, and the Mayor and City Clerk shall be authorized to make, execute and deliver a good and sufficient warranty deed on behalf of the said City of Payette, Idaho, for the due conveying of said above described property to the purchaser.

Section 3.

At least ten days notice of said special election shall be given by the City Clerk of the said City of Payette, Idaho, by publication of notice thereof in the Payette Enterprise, the official newspaper of said City of Payette, published and having general circulation therein, and by posting such notice in three of the most public places within the corporate limits of the said City of Payette, Idaho, and such publication and such posting of such notice, shall be made at least 10 days before the holding of said special election; and the said election shall be conducted as provided by law, relative to the holding of special elections, for the purpose of authorizing the sale of real estate by cities of the second class, in the state of Idaho.

Section 4.

The voting at said special election shall be by ballot, and said ballot shall be so prepared as to permit the voter to express his desire for or against the said selling and conveying of said property, for not less than \$2,000. in cash, and such ballot shall be substantially in the following form, to-wit: Shall the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, be authorized to sell and convey for not less than \$2,000. in cash, the following described real property belonging to the said City of Payette, situate in the City of Payette, County of Payette, State of Idaho, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Lot 8, Block 1 of Corrie's Addition to the City of Payette, Idaho, according to the official plat of said addition now on file and of record in the office of the County Recorder of Payette County, Idaho, under the provisions of Ordinance No. 317 of the City of Payette, Idaho; The choice of the elector shall be expressed by his placing a cross (X) in the appropriate circle to be provided for on said ballots.

Section 5.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper.


