

ORDINANCE NO. 370 BY

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 33 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PLAYING OF GAMES OF BALL AND FOOTBALL, AND THE THROWING, BATTING OR KICKING OF ANY HAND BALL, OR FOOTBALL WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, ON SUNDAYS", AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE # 75 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, PASSED AND APPROVED THE 7TH DAY OF JUNE, 1906, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE # 231 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, PASSED AND APPROVED THE 7TH DAY OF MAY, 1913.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and the Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1.

That Ordinance No. 33 of the City of Payette, entitled "an ordinance prohibiting the playing of games of ball and football within the limits of the City of Payette, on Sundays" passed and approved on the 9th day of September, 1903, as amended by Ordinance No. 75 of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled "An Ordinance amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 33 of the City of Payette, Idaho, entitled "An Ordinance prohibiting the playing of games of ball and football within the limits of the City of Payette, on Sundays", and fixing the bounds in the said City of Payette within which the said games shall not be played on Sunday". Passed and approved the 7th day of June, 1906, as amended by Ordinance No. 231 of the City of Payette, entitled "An Ordinance prohibiting the playing of the games of ball and football, and throwing, batting or kicking of any hand ball, or football within the limits of the City of Payette, on Sundays" and fixing the bounds in the City of Payette within which the said games shall not be played on Sundays", passed and approved the 7th day of May, 1913, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 2.

This ordinance to take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
