

ORDINANCE NO. 323 BY SHEERWOOD.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PLANTING, TRIMMING AND CARE OF TREES AND SHRUBS IN THE PUBLIC PARKS, STREETS AND GROUNDS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AND REGULATING THE CARE, PROTECTION AND OVERSIGHT OF PUBLIC PARKS, AND STREETS, AND PROVIDING A PUNISHMENT FOR ANY VIOLATION OF SUCH REGULATIONS.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to plant, trim, spray, remove, destroy, cut, deface or in any wise injure any tree or shrub in any of the streets, avenues, parks, or public highways in the City of Payette, Idaho, without first applying for and obtaining a permit therefor from the City Clerk, and which permit shall specifically describe the work to be done under it, and shall be void twenty days after its date.

Section 2.

It shall be unlawful for any person to hitch or fasten any horse or other animal to any tree, shrub, fountain, monument, lamppost, telephone pole, electric light pole, or any other ornament or improvement growing or situated in any public street, avenue, public park, public highway or public place within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, except it be to a duly and regularly established hitch post or rack.

Section 3.

It shall be unlawful for any person to allow any animal under his control to stand near enough to any such tree or shrub to bite, rub against or otherwise injure the same.

Section 4.

It shall be unlawful for any person to remove any buildings or other objects so as to injure or interfere with any tree or shrub, statue, monument or other improvement standing in any street or avenue or public place, or place any advertisement, announcement or notice, or print, scratch, cut or mark the same upon any tree or shrub, statue, monument or other improvement situate in any street, avenue, highway or public place within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 5.

It shall be unlawful for the owner or agent of any property or premises situate within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, to permit or allow any dead tree, limbs, or overhanging bows injurious to life, limb or property to remain upon said premises after notice in writing to such owner or agent from the Chief of Police to remove the same within five days after receipt of such notice.

Section 6.

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to use threatening, abusive, insulting or indecent language in any park in the City of Payette, Idaho, or to create any nuisance or disturbance, or damage, scratch, cut, injure or deface any of the buildings, fences, structures, or foul any of the fountains or any other improvement or to cut or injure the flowers or flower beds within such parks or for the owner of any dog to allow the same to run at large within such parks.

Section 7.

The right is hereby given to the Mountain States Telephone and Telegraph Company and to the Idaho Power Company to trim any and all trees the branches of which interfere with telephone or electric light wires and cables, without consulting with or obtaining permission from the owners of any adjoining property. Provided however, that such trimming shall be done under the supervision of the Chief of Police of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 8.

It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firms or corporation to hold any meeting, gathering or picnic or musical, theatrical or other entertainment in any park of the City of Payette, Idaho, without first having received a license from the Clerk of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 9.

It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firms or corporation to wilfully violate any of the by-laws, rules and regulations governing the public parks and grounds of the City of Payette, Idaho, made by the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 10.

It shall be unlawful for any person to plant or set out any trees or shrubs upon the streets or highways of the City of Payette, Idaho, except such as are provided for and are permitted by the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho, and after such permission is given, such trees or shrubs shall be planted in such manner as said board shall direct.

Section 11.

Any person or persons, firm or corporation violating any of the foregoing provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof be punished by fine not exceeding \$100.00 and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof shall immediately be committed and be confined in the city jail of the City of Payette, one day for each \$2.00 of such fine and costs.


Section 12.

Section 13.


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper of the City of Payette, Idaho.
