

ORDINANCE NO. 330 BY MUSGROVE.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 294 OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, ENTITLED: " AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE RIDING OF BICYCLES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF;" AND PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN PERSONS MAY RIDE BICYCLES ON SIDEWALKS IN THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1.

That Ordinance No. 294 of the City of Payette, Idaho, is hereby repealed.

Section 2.

It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle on any sidewalk, or the parking between the roadway and the sidewalk within the corporate limits of the said City of Payette, except, cripples, police officers in the actual discharge of their duties, and regular employees of the Post Office in Payette, Idaho, in the discharge of their duties in the delivery and distribution of mail in the said City of Payette.

Section 3.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined on conviction thereof in a sum not less than \$3.00 and not more than \$100.00.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper of the City of Payette, Idaho.
