

ORDINANCE NO. 350 BY Shurwood.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING AN ANNUAL APPROPRIATION AND LEVY FOR GENERAL ROAD, SALARY, STREET LIGHTING AND LIBRARY PURPOSES; AND THE PAYMENT OF INTEREST ON THE OUTSTANDING BONDED INDEBTEDNESS, AND THE REDEMPTION OF OUTSTANDING WARRANT INDEBTEDNESS OF SAID CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

Be it ordained by the mayor and council of the city of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1: That the sum of \$ 4500.00, together all fines and moneys not otherwise appropriated, is hereby appropriated for the General Expenses of the City of Payette, Idaho, for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday of May, A.D. 1921.

Section 2: That the sum of \$ 7,200.00, is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A.D. 1921, for the purposes of building and keeping in repair all roads and streets within the corporate limits of the said City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 3: That the sum of \$ 6300.00, is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A.D. 1921, for the purposes of paying all salaries of the various officers of the said City of Payette, Idaho,

Section 4: That the sum of \$ 5100.00, is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A.D. 1921, for the purpose of lighting the streets and thoroughfares of the said City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 5: That the sum of \$ 9900.00, is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A.D. 1921, for the purpose of paying interest on all General Bond issues of said City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the Bond Interest Fund.

Section 6: That the sum of \$ 1500.00, is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing on the first Tuesday in May, A.D. 1921, for redemption of the outstanding warrant indebtedness of said City of Payette, Idaho, and the same shall constitute the warrant redemption fund.

Section 7: That the sum of \$ 600.00, is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year commencing with the first Tuesday of May, A.D. 1921, for library purposes and the same shall constitute the Library Fund of said City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 8: That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first Tuesday in May, A.D. 1921, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, State of Idaho, the sum of 15 mills, on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property, and the funds realized from from such levy, together with all licenses and fines and moneys not otherwise appropriated, shall be for and constitute the general fund of the said City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 9: That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first Tuesday in May, A.D. 1921, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, State of Idaho, the sum of 8.25 mills, on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property, and the funds realized from such levy, shall be and constitute the Bond Interest Fund of said City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 10: That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first Tuesday of May, A.D. 1921, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, State of Idaho, the sum of 1.75 mills, on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property, and the funds realized from such levy, shall be and constitute the Warrant Redemption Fund of said City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 11: That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first Tuesday of May, A.D. 1921, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, State of Idaho, the sum of .5 mills, on the dollar of the assessed valuation of said property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be the Library Fund of said City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 12: That there is hereby levied for the fiscal year commencing with the first Tuesday in May, A.D. 1921, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, State of Idaho, the sum of 3.5 mills, on each one dollar of the assessed valuation of said property, and the funds realized from such levy shall be and constitute the Street Lighting Fund of said City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 13: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper of said City of Payette, Idaho.
