

ORDINANCE NO. 355-By Sherwood

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DRIVING, MOVING AND DRAWING OF ANY TRACTOR, THRESHING MACHINE OR OTHER VEHICLE HAVING CLEATS, FLANGES OR LUGS ON THE WHEELS THEREOF OVER OR UPON ANY PAVED OR HARD SURFACED STREET, ALLEY OR AVENUE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, STATE OF IDAHO, AND PROVIDING A PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE.

Be It Ordained by the Mayor and the Council of the City of Payette,  
State of Idaho:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to move, drive or draw any threshing machine, tractor or other vehicle, with cleats, flanges or lugs on the wheels thereof, upon or across any paved or hard surfaced street, alley or avenue of the City of Payette, State of Idaho.

Section 2. Any person, persons, firm or corporation who shall so drive, move or draw any such threshing machine, tractor or other vehicle over or upon any paved or hard surfaced street, alley or avenue of the said City of Payette, State of Idaho, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
