

ORDINANCE No. 369

An Ordinance granting to the Oregon Short Line Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, a franchise and right to construct, operate, maintain and use a coal dock, in Sixth Street, between Center Avenue and First Avenue South in the City of Payette, Idaho.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1: That a franchise be, and the same is hereby granted to the Oregon Short Line Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, to construct, operate, maintain and use a coal dock, being twelve and three-tenths (12.3) feet wide and forty and two-tenths (40.2) feet long, in Sixth Street, between Center Avenue and First Avenue South in the City of Payette, Idaho, and eight and five-tenths (8.5) feet Westerly from and parallel to the present spur track constructed along the center of said Sixth Street. The location of said coal dock being more particularly shown in yellow upon the attached print, which is hereby made a part of this Ordinance.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force 15 days after its passage, and shall be effective for a period of five (5) years from and after the effective date hereof.
