

ORDINANCE NO. 396

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 6,7, and 9 of ARTICLE II, CHAPTER VII OF THE GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ENTITLED "DOGS".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO.

Section 1. That Section 6 of Article II, Chapter VII of the General Ordinances of the City of Payette, Idaho, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6. Any person who shall own or keep any dog, whelp, slut or bitch within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, and permit the same to run at large without having first obtained a license therefor, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars for each and every offence.

Section 2. That Section 7 of Article II, Chapter VII of the General Ordinances of the City of Payette, Idaho, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to issue a license to any person applying therefor, upon the payment of one dollar per head for each dog, whelp, and sterilized slut or bitch, and two dollars for each unsterilized slut or bitch, each and every year, said license to be dated from the first of the fiscal year in which it is granted. Such license fee shall be due and payable on or before the fifteenth day of April of each and every year.

Section 3. That Section 9 of Article II, Chapter VII of the General Ordinances of the City of Payette, Idaho, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 9. It is hereby made and shall be the duty of the City Marshal of the City of Payette, Idaho, or any officer appointed by the Mayor and City Council for that purpose, to seize and impound in a pound provided by the City of Payette, any and all dogs, whelps, sluts or bitches found running at large within the corporate limits of said City, unless marked and licensed as in this Ordinance provided, and to forthwith post, in three conspicuous places in the said City, for not less than five days, a written or printed notice containing a description of the dog or dogs seized and impounded by him, the date of the seizure and impounding, and the time and place the said dog or dogs will be offered for sale. If, at any time prior to sale, the owner of any dog or dogs so seized and impounded shall claim the same, he shall be entitled to the possession thereof, upon the payment to the Marshal, or any officer in charge of the pound, the sum of three dollars per head for each dog, whelp, slut or bitch so held in pound, together with the payment of all legal charges and expenses incident to the seizure and impounding of said dog or dogs. If any dog, whelp, slut or bitch so impounded is not claimed by the owner and all costs of redemption paid within five days after the posting of notice of seizure and impounding, the said dog or dogs shall be offered for sale to the highest bidder, provided, that no bid will be accepted that does not equal the cost of redemption by an owner, and if there be no sale of said dog or dogs, then it shall be the duty of the said officer to kill the said dog or dogs without further delay.

Section 4. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official newspaper of the City of Payette, Idaho.
