

ORDINANCE NO. 56.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE VILLAGE OF PAYETTE TO A CITY OF THE SECOND CLASS, AND DIVIDING THE CITY OF PAYETTE INTO WARDS.

Be it Ordained by the Chairman and Board of Trustees of the Village of Payette:

Section 1.

That the Village of Payette be and hereby is a City of the second class, and is and shall be known and designated as the City of Payette.

Section 2.

That the City of Payette be and hereby is divided into three wards with metes and bounds as follows:

First Ward: All that part of Payette lying North of Main Street and East of the main track of the Oregon Short Line Railway.

Second Ward: All that part of Payette lying South of Main Street and East of the main track of the Oregon Short Line Railway.

Third Ward: All that part of Payette lying West of the main track of the Oregon Short Line Railway.
