ORDINANCE NO. 96 BY H. P. Ackerman

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF RUBBISH ON THE STREETS, ALLEYS OR LOTS WITHIN THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE AND PROVIDING THE PUNISHMENT THEREFOR.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to burn on any street, alley or lot within the fire limits of the City of Payette, any paper, trash or rubbish, except the same be burnt in a drum or other covered enclosure, such as is ordinarily used for burning rubbish.

Section 2. Any person who shall kindle any fire on any street, alley or lot within the said fire limits, unless the same be enclosed as is provided in section 1 of this ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than two dollars nor more than one hundred dollars or imprisoned in the city jail not exceeding fifty days or both such fine and imprisonment.
