

RESOLUTION NUMBER 236

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ADOPTING A POLICY ON PLACING MEMORIALS IN CITY PARKS;

WHEREAS from time to time people and organizations want to place memorials in City parks in remembrance of friends and loved ones; and

WHEREAS The City encourages the placing of memorials in public areas which enhance the appearance and utility of public property:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1: There is hereby established a policy for the placement of memorials upon City property.

MEMORIAL POLICY

A. Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to establish a written policy of the City of Payette whereby individuals and groups can remember loved ones, friends, and individuals by having a memorial placed on Payette City property.

B. Types of Memorials:

1. The following types of memorials are hereby approved.

a. Living Memorials - Living memorials are trees or shrubs which are approved by the Parks Department and the Tree Committee for placement in a City park. Roses bushes planted in the existing rose garden in Central Park.

b. Non living Memorials -

1. Benches approved by the Parks Department may be placed in City Parks under the direction of the Parks Department.

2. Park Amenities such as drinking fountains, permanent picnic tables, child safe playground equipment and permanent trash containers.

C. Memorial Registry

1. Applications for placement of memorials will be submitted to the Clerk's office on a form provided by the City. An application must include a description of the memorial, proposed date of installation, name and address of donor, proposed location, plaque

copy information and life expectancy of the memorial.

2. When an application for a memorial is submitted, an applicant will be provided with alternatives available to the donor to renew or enhance the memorial.

D. Location and Makeup: The City of Payette, through the Parks Department, shall control, manage and approve the type, makeup, composition and placement of all memorials located on City property.

E. Maintenance: After the City has accepted a memorial, Parks Department will provide ongoing care and maintenance of those memorials during the time the memorials remain viable, attractive and acceptable memorials. In the event applicants desire to have extraordinary maintenance or maintenance in addition to that provided by the Parks Department, an applicant may have the option of providing additional funding. Any additional maintenance will continue to be administered by City of Payette parks department.

F. REPLACEMENT: The City shall not be responsible for replacement or repair of any memorial that may be destroyed, badly damaged or which has substantially deteriorated

The following list sets forth items which are approved by the City at the present time. This list does not preclude the use of similar items of comparable quality or the submission of additional items which may subsequently be submitted to the City for approval.
