

**PAYETTE CITY COUNCIL
Resolution 2006-04**

**A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO TITLE 13 OF
THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE
SETTING WATER & SEWER FEES (AMENDED)**

WHEREAS, the City of Payette, Idaho ("City") is a municipal corporation operating under the laws of the State of Idaho and is authorized to fix rates and charges and take such other actions incidental to the construction, management and operation of a municipal water system and a municipal sewer system pursuant to Title 50, Chapter 10, Idaho Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted in the Payette Municipal Code, Title 13, the following fees are hereby adopted:

Water tap fees are established as follows:

Water Line Size	Cost
3/4-inch	\$1,500
1-inch	\$1,800
2-inch	\$3,000
4-inch	At city cost
6-inch	At city cost

The water permit fee shall be \$750.00.

The sewer permit fee shall be \$750.00.

Involuntarily shut off fee \$30.00. **One free involuntary shut off per calendar year is allowed.**

Turn on fee after involuntary shut off \$30.00. **One free involuntary turn on per calendar year is allowed.**
(total turn off/ on shall be \$60.00)

Voluntary shut-off: no fee for the first off/on cycle per calendar year.

Voluntary turn on: no fee for the first off/on cycle per calendar year.

Voluntary shut off for second or subsequent request during that calendar year: turn on \$30.00.

Voluntary turn on for second or subsequent request during that calendar year: turn on \$30.00.


~~A resident~~ **The property owner** shall be responsible for the monthly base water and sewer fees whether the meter is on or off. In the event of non payment, the water and sewer monthly base fees shall accrue. Any accrued amount shall be paid in full prior to a turn on of the water service. The accrued monthly base fees (combined) shall not exceed the water permit fee.

Each year, the above set out fees, together with the monthly water and sewer rates (both base fees and the usage rates) shall be compared to the US Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor and Statistics Data, Consumer Price index, and shall be adjusted by the City Council to reflect changes in that index.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, upon motion duly made and seconded, this resolution shall be in full force and effect commencing with the billing cycle July 1, 2006.


