

RESOLUTION 187

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE PAYETTE CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT AS THE LOCAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE AUTHORITY FOR HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE INCIDENTS OCCURRING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 30-7105 (2) (A) mandates that the governing body of every city shall designate by ordinance or resolution a local emergency response authority for hazardous substance incidents within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Payette City Fire Department is the most appropriate agency to be designated as a Hazardous Material Response Authority, having trained personnel and appropriate equipment,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. That the Payette City Fire Department is hereby designated by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette to be the emergency response authority for hazardous substance incidents that occur within the corporate limits of the City of Payette.

Section 2. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.
