

RESOLUTION NO. 229

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE DATE, TIME, AND PLACE OF A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER WHETHER THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, SHOULD ADOPT A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A PETITION FOR JUDICIAL CONFIRMATION UNDER TITLE 7, CHAPTER 13, IDAHO CODE; APPROVING A FORM OF NOTICE OF HEARING AND DIRECTING THE PUBLICATION THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE BY MAIL TO ANY PERSON REQUESTING SUCH NOTICE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, as follows:

Section 1: A public hearing before the City Council of the City of Payette, Payette County, Idaho (the "City"), is hereby called for Monday, the 5th day of June, 2000, at 6:30 o'clock P.M., at the City Council meeting room at Payette City Hall, 700 Center Avenue, Payette, Idaho, for the purpose of considering the adoption by the City Council of a resolution authorizing the filing of a petition for judicial confirmation under the Idaho Judicial Confirmation Law, Title 7, Chapter 13, Idaho Code, seeking judicial confirmation of the authority of the City (1) to incur an indebtedness as an "ordinary and necessary expense" of the City authorized by the general laws of the state within the meaning of Article 8, Section 3 of the Idaho Constitution, in an amount not to exceed \$1,400,000 for the purpose of financing the cost of necessary improvements to its wastewater treatment facilities; (2) to enter into a loan agreement and to issue its promissory note or other evidence of indebtedness for the same; and (3) to pledge the net revenues of its sanitary sewer system for the payment of such indebtedness.

Section 2: Notice of the public hearing, substantially in the form which is annexed hereto as Exhibit "A," shall be published once in the official newspaper of the City, at least fifteen (15) days prior to the public hearing, in the manner required by Section 7-1304, Idaho Code.

Section 3: In accordance with Section 7-1304(3), Idaho Code, as amended, a copy of the notice of public hearing shall be sent by certified mail, at least fourteen (14) days before the public hearing, by the City Clerk to all persons who request, in writing, a copy of notice of meetings of the City Council at which a public hearing will be held to consider a resolution or ordinance authorizing the filing of a petition for judicial confirmation. If a request for notice is received within fourteen (14) days of the public hearing, the City Clerk shall send a copy of the notice by certified mail as soon as possible after the receipt of such request.
