

RESOLUTION 200

A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING A GENERAL CITY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 7, 1995, DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACE, AND ORDERING THE CITY CLERK TO GIVE NOTICE OF SUCH ELECTION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The general City election will be held in and for the City of Payette on the 7th day of November, 1995, at which time there will be elected three City Council members to serve for a term of four years, or until the election and qualification of their successors.

SECTION 2. The following is designated as the polling place for such election:


CITY - WIDE PRECINCT


Payette Public Library
24 South 10th Street

The polling place shall be open for voting from 8:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk, for and on behalf of the Mayor and City Council, shall give notice of the time and place of holding such general City election by posting such notice in three public places or publishing such notice in at least two issues of the Independent Enterprise, a newspaper printed and published in the City of Payette, Idaho, the first publication of such notice to be made not less than 45 days previous to the date of such City election and the last publication not less than 15 days prior to the election; the notice so published shall state the polling place in each precinct and the hours during which the polls shall be open for the purpose of voting; said notice to contain such information in accordance with the requirements of Section 50-436 of the Idaho Code.
