

RESOLUTION 250

A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, PAYETTE COUNTY, IDAHO, SUPPORTING THE PROJECT IDENTIFICATION SUBMITTAL FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND RE-ALIGNMENT OF HIGHWAY #52 FROM THE INTERSECTION OF IOWA AND HIGHWAY #52 TO SOUTH MAIN STREET (BUSINESS ALTERNATE #95), CONNECTING TO HIGHWAY #52 AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH SECOND AVENUE SOUTH AND CONTINUING NORTH AND DESIGNATING THE NEW ROUTE AS HIGHWAY #52 TO THE IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, DISTRICT 3.

WHEREAS, the City of Payette has determined that the construction and re-alignment of Highway #52 beginning at the intersection of Iowa and Highway #52 would be beneficial to the community due to increased traffic; and

WHEREAS, it is the City of Payette's understanding that the newly constructed section of Highway #52 will include a 47 foot street section including curb and gutter plus 5 foot sidewalks, bike paths and street lighting on both sides and a stoplight at the intersection of the new Highway #52 and Highway #95; and

WHEREAS, the City of Payette has determined that the new route for Highway #52 would travel west from the approximate location of the intersection of Iowa and Highway #52 to South Main Street (Business Alternate #95) and then north to connect to the present intersection of Highway #52 and Second Avenue South and on to the north; and

WHEREAS, the City of Payette has determined that the intersection of Iowa and Highway #52 is in need of re-construction to meet safety standards and increased traffic needs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Payette has determined that the section of Highway #52 that is proposed to be turned over to the City of Payette to be used and maintained as a City street does not meet City standards and will need upgrades as part of the project; and


WHEREAS, the City of Payette has determined that the intersection of Highway #52 and Sixth Avenue South does not meet State or City standards and needs to be closed with a cul de sac at the east end of Sixth Avenue South as part of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Payette has determined that the timing of the closure of the intersection of Sixth Avenue South and Highway #52 and the construction and re-alignment of Highway #52 should coincide in order to facilitate increasing traffic accessing Highway #95.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE SUPPORT THE PROJECT AS OUTLINED.
