Review -- Quick Review 17 Comp Plan Elements – Jerome Mapp

Elements for Review Today from the 2005 Comp Plan

- *What you like least?*
- *What issues, problems, or opportunities are missing?*
- *Which parts of old plan feel outdated or need revision?*
- *Are there parts of the old plan that should be retained?*
- *Are there new solution options we should consider?*
- *Have your mapping needs changed?*

Transportation (Section 9) - an analysis showing the community's transportation infrastructure which addresses efficient mobility of people, goods and services.

Land Use (Section 6) - encompasses the current mix of future land uses.

National Interest Electrical Transportation Corridors (New) - After notification by the public utilities commission concerning the likelihood of a federally designated national interest electric transmission corridor, prepare an analysis showing the existing location and possible routing of high voltage transmission lines, including national interest electric transmission corridors based upon the United States department of energy's most recent national electric transmission congestion study pursuant to sections 368 and 1221 of the energy policy act of 2005. "High-voltage transmission lines" means lines with a capacity of one hundred fifteen thousand (115,000) volts or more supported by structures of forty (40) feet or more in height.

Public Services, Facilities and Utilities (Section 8) - an analysis showing general plans for sewage, water supply, fire stations, public safety facilities, library, energy and related services.

Public Airport Facilities (New) - An analysis prepared with assistance from the Idaho transportation department division of aeronautics, if requested by the planning and zoning commission, and the manager or person in charge of the local public airport identifying, but not limited to, facility locations, the scope and type of airport operations, existing and future planned airport development and infrastructure needs, and the economic impact to the community.

Agriculture (New) - An analysis of the agricultural base of the area including agricultural lands, farming activities, farming-related businesses and the role of agriculture and agricultural uses in the community.
