

ORDINANCE 1022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ANNEXING THAT REAL PROPERTY WHICH IS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1; ESTABLISHING ZONING; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; REPEALER; EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING FOR PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY;

Be it ordained and resolved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 1: That real property which is described as:
Real property being a portion of Block 4, 5, and 11 of Recorder's Plat of Section 34, Township 9 North and Range 5 West of Boise Meridian and is more particularly described as follows;
Commencing at the Southeast corner of the NW 1/4, NE 1/4 of said section 34;
Thence west a distance of 253.4 feet along the south boundary of said NW 1/4, NE 1/4 to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;
Thence south 408.33 feet parallel with the east boundary of said NE 1/4;
Thence west 532.34 feet, more or less, to the easterly right-of-way of Lower Payette Ditch;
Thence N 01 16' W a distance 408.43 feet along said right-of-way;
Thence N 11 00' W a distance of 495.0 feet along said right-of-way;
Thence E a distance of 627.5 feet parallel with south boundary of said NW 1/4, NE 1/4;
Thence south a distance of 486.0 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Section 2: Upon annexation that property shall be zoned 'A' Residential, but it is found to be a mined out clay or gravel pit.

Section 3: If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remaining portion of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: Any portions of any existing Ordinances which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its adoption and publication as required by law.

Section 6: The Ordinance may be published by summary as provided by Idaho Code.

BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS APPROVAL, PASSAGE, AND PUBLICATION AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 5th day of August, 1991.
