

ORDINANCE NO. 1024

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 10.20.090 OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE AND SUBSTITUTING THEREFORE A NEW SECTION WHICH SHALL BE KNOWN AS SECTION 10.20.90; ADDING A NEW SECTION 10.20.095; ADDING NEW SECTIONS 10.20.240 THROUGH 10.20.260; SETTING A TIME LIMIT ON PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS; SETTING A FINE; PROHIBITING MOVING FOR THE PURPOSE OF EVADING THE ORDINANCE; PROHIBITING STOPPING IN CERTAIN AREAS; PROVIDING ADMINISTRATIVE REMEDIES; PROVIDING ANGLE PARKING; PROVIDING FOR HANDICAPPED PARKING; PROVIDING PENALTIES; REPEALER; SEVERABILITY; EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1: Section 1.20.090 of the Payette Municipal Code is hereby repealed.

Section 2: There are hereby created new Sections of the Payette Municipal Code which sections shall be known as and designated as Sections 10.20.090., 10.20.095, 10.20.240, 10.20.250, and 10.20.260. Said sections shall read as follows:

Section 10.20.090 Time restriction in certain areas--- designated--penalty for violation. A. It is the purpose of this section to alleviate traffic congestion and to alleviate parking congestion caused by numerous operators of motor vehicles who park their vehicles for unreasonably long periods of time in the most congested streets of the city and thus impede traffic.

B. It is unlawful to park any motor vehicle for more than two hours continuously at any one place between eight a.m. and six p.m., on any day except on Sundays and legal holidays, upon 1st avenue North between the alley one-half block West of Main Street and the alley one-half block East of Main Street; Center Avenue between 7th Street and 9th Street; 1st Avenue South between Main Street and the alley one-half block East of Main Street; Main Street between 3rd Avenue North and 3rd Avenue South; the West side of 9th Street between 1st Avenue South and Center Avenue; the East side of 7th Street between 1st Avenue South and Center Avenue.

C. Any person convicted of a violation of subsection B of this Section for the first time shall be fined five (5) dollars. Upon second or subsequent conviction of a violation of said subsection, within any ninety (90) day period, the fine shall be fifteen (15) dollars.

D. It is unlawful for the operator of any motor vehicle to move

nonpayment in accordance with administrative procedure set out hereinabove, a uniform citation or complaint charging an infraction for a parking violation or for failure to pay a parking penalty may be filed in the Magistrate Division of the District Court. A parking violation or failure to pay the parking violation is an infraction.

Section 3: If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remaining portion of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: All Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5: The Ordinance may be published by Summary as provided by Idaho Code.

BE IT ORDAINED THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS APPROVAL, PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION AS REQUIRED BY LAW.
