

ORDINANCE 1027

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE IDAHO, AMENDING THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 9.27 AND A NEW SECTION 9.27.010 WHICH MAKES IT UNLAWFUL AND A MISDEMEANOR TO SNIFF OR INHALE CERTAIN SUBSTANCES; CREATING A PENALTY; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALER; SEVERABILITY:

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. Title 9 is hereby amended with the addition of a new section Chapter 27 and a new Section which is designated as Section 9.27.010 and which reads as follows:

9.27.010. It shall be unlawful and a misdemeanor for any person to sniff, smell, inhale or ingest in any manner, any fumes emanating from gasoline, paint, glue or any other foreign substance obtained without a prescription, for the purpose of inducing an euphoric state, to experience a mind altering effect, to cause an hallucination, to induce a mind altering effect or for the purpose of getting high. Any person found guilty of violating this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and may be punished by either imprisonment in the Payette County jail for a period not to exceed 6 months or by a fine not to exceed \$300.00, or by both such fine or imprisonment.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as provided by law.

Section 3. This ordinance may be published by summary as provided by law.

Section 4. If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and shall constitute Ordinance 1027.

Section 5. All ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.
