

ORDINANCE 1045

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, REQUIRING A PERMIT BEFORE CUTTING, SCORING OR DAMAGING A CITY STREET, CURB, GUTTER OR SIDEWALK; PROVIDING A PENALTY; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; REPEALER; EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING FOR PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 1: Payette City Code is hereby amended by adding the following requirement.

Any person, firm, corporation, private utility, public utility, partnership or any other entity before cutting, scoring, damaging, boring under or crossing a city street, curb, gutter or sidewalk, shall first notify the city clerk and obtain a permit from the clerk authorizing such action

Section 2: There shall be no charge for the permit.

Section 3: Any person who shall cut, damage, score or bore under the street without the necessary permit shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished in accordance with misdemeanor statutes of the State of Idaho.

Section 4: If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remaining portion of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5: Any portions of any existing Ordinances which are in direct conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 6: The Ordinance may be published by summary as provided by Idaho Code.

BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER IT APPROVAL, PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 18 day of May, 1992.
