

ORDINANCE 1051

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE IDAHO, PROHIBITING THE USE OF BOWS AND ARROWS; CREATING A PENALTY; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALER; SEVERABILITY:

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section 1. Title 9 is hereby amended with the addition of new Sections 9.62.020 and 9.62.030, which Sections shall read as follows:

9.62.020: It shall be unlawful for any person to fire, discharge or shoot any bow and arrow within or into the City Limits. The term bow shall include but not necessarily be limited to a standard bow, compound bow, recurve bow, long bow, hunting bow, cross bow or any other bow designed to propel an arrow.

9.62.030: Any person who is found to have violated this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished in accordance with the misdemeanor statutes of the State of Idaho.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after it's passage and publication as provided by law.

Section 3. This ordinance may be published by summary as provided by law.

Section 4. If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and shall constitute Ordinance 1051.

Section 5. All ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.
