

ORDINANCE 1054

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING SECTION 8.28.030 OF THE PAYETTE CITY CODE BY CHANGING THE DATES IN WHICH BURNING IS ALLOWED; PROVIDING A PENALTY; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; REPEALER; EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING FOR PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 1: Section 8.28.030 of the Payette City Code is hereby amended as follows.

8.28.080: Unless otherwise designated by the Mayor and city Council, burning shall be permitted two months during the spring ~~months of March and April~~ and two months during the fall ~~of the months of September and October~~ each and every year. Burning hours shall be between the hours of eight a.m. and eight p.m. Those monthly periods shall be designated by the City Fire Chief.

Section 2: If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be unenforceable or unconstitutional for any reason, the remaining portion of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: Any portions of any existing Ordinances which are in direct conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 4: The Ordinance may be published by summary as provided by Idaho Code.

BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER IT APPROVAL, PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 21st day of September 1992.
