

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1129

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING TITLE 12 CHAPTER 12.04 BY ADDING A NEW SECTION WHICH SHALL BE DESIGNATED AS SECTION 12.04.270 AND WHICH SHALL REQUIRE A MINIMUM RIGHT-OF-WAY WIDTH OR 80 FEET ALONG QUARTER SECTION AND SECTION LINES; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; REPEALER; ALLOWING PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. Title 12, Chapter 12.04 is hereby amended by adding a new section which shall be designated as section 12.04.270 and which Section shall read as follows:

12.04.270 Minimum Right-of-Way on Section and Quarter Section Lines. In addition to any other standard or specification required by the City of Payette for street rights-of way, all streets which are developed along section lines or quarter section lines, or any easements which are granted for future development along those lines, shall provide a minimum street width of eighty (80) feet.

Section 2. Any ordinances which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.


Section 3. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall constitute Ordinance Number 1129.

Section 4. This Ordinance may be published by summary in accordance with the Statutes of the State of Idaho.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
