

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1181

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, REPEALING SECTIONS 2.08.020, 2.22.020 AND 2.34.020 OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE, WHICH SECTIONS ARE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. Sections 2.08.020, 2.22.020 and 2.34.020 of the Payette Municipal Code are hereby repealed.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.

Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 4. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall constitute Ordinance Number 1181.

Section 5. This Ordinance may be published by summary in accordance with the Statutes of the State of Idaho.
