

ORDINANCE NO. 1186

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING SECTION 13.04.260 OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE TO CHANGE THE WATER RATES; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. Section 13.04.260 of Title 13 of the Payette Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

13.04.260 Water Charges - Designated.

A. The monthly charges for water shall be made and collected at the following rates for each meter service; however in the event there is more than one dwelling unit, as defined in Section 17.08.110 of this Code, connected to a water meter, then the charges shall be made and collected for each dwelling unit by determining the average use per dwelling unit.

B. The minimum monthly charge for each meter service within the City limits shall be ~~five dollars eighty cents (\$5.80)~~ six dollars forty cents (\$6.40) for each unit. Where there is more than one unit connected to a single water meter, the charges shall be ~~five dollars eighty cents (\$5.80)~~ six dollars forty cents (\$6.40) for each unit which is not connected to the water meter but is supplied through the meter. This minimum charge shall entitle the user to the delivery of two thousand (2,000) gallons of water during each such month.

C. For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of two thousand (2,000) gallons and not to exceed ~~two hundred fifty thousand (250,000)~~ five million (5,000,000) gallons, the charge shall be ~~thirteen and one half cents (\$.135)~~ fifteen cents (\$.15) for each one hundred (100) gallons or fraction thereof.

D. For all amounts of water used in any month in excess of ~~two hundred fifty thousand (250,000)~~ five million (5,000,000) gallons, the charge shall be ~~nine cents (\$.09)~~ ten cents (\$.10) for each one hundred (100) gallons or fraction thereof.


Section 2. Any ordinances which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.


Section 3. If any portion of this ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the ordinance shall constitute ordinance 1186.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
