

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1189

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, SETTING A MORATORIUM ON THE TRAPPING AND KILLING OF DOMESTIC AND FERAL CATS; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, except an official of the City of Payette, a person designated by a City official or a Licensed Veterinarian or their designee to trap and kill domestic and feral cats within the City limits.

Section 2. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor punishable by not more than five (5) days in the Payette County Jail or a fine of not more than \$300.00 or both.

Section 3. An emergency being found to exist this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall constitute Ordinance Number 1189.

Section 6. This Ordinance may be published by summary in accordance with the Statutes of the State of Idaho.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1189

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, CREATING A NEW SECTION 6.04.110 OF THE PAYETTE CITY CODE SECTION CREATES A MORATORIUM ON THE TRAPPING AND KILLING OF DOMESTIC AND FERAL CATS; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER; ESTABLISHING A PENALTY;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. There is hereby created a new Section 6.04.110 of the Payette City Code which section shall read as follows:

6.04.110: Moratorium on the Trapping and Killing of Cats: It shall be unlawful for any person, except an official of the City of Payette, a person designated by a City official or a Licensed Veterinarian or their designee to trap and kill domestic and feral cats within the City limits.

Section 2. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be made a misdemeanor punishable by not more than five (5) days in the Payette County Jail or a fine of not more than \$300.00 or both.

Section 3. An emergency being found to exist this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.


Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.


Section 6. This Ordinance may be published by summary in accordance with the Statutes of the State of Idaho.
