

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1208

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING SECTIONS 2.52.010 AND 2.52.020 OF THE PAYETTE CITY CODE BY DESIGNATING THE PLANNING COMMISSION AS THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION, BY DECREASING THE NUMBER OF PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION MEMBERS FROM TEN (10) MEMBERS TO SEVEN (7) MEMBERS, BY ALLOWING A RESIDENT OF THE IMPACT AREA TO SERVE ON THE COMMISSION AND BY FILLING A VACANCY BY APPOINTMENT AND CONFIRMATION; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. Section 2.52.010 of the Payette City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.52.010 Created. There is created a planning and zoning commission for the city, which commission shall be known and designated as the City of Payette Planning and Zoning Commission. The Planning and Zoning Commission may from time to time be referred to as simply the Planning Commission or as the Commission.

Section 1. Section 2.52.020 of the Payette City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.52.020 Composition-- Qualifications--Term of office.

A. ~~The Planning and Zoning Commission shall consist of the mayor and attorney, ex-officio, and ten--other seven (7) members to be appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the council,--at least one of which members shall be a qualified engineer.~~

B. All members shall be residents and taxpayers of the city, except that one member may be a nonresident taxpayer from without the city limits resident of the Payette City impact area.

C. All appointed members of the planning commission shall be appointed for and shall hold office for a term of six years. In the event of the death, resignation or any vacancy in said commission, ~~the mayor is authorized an empowered to fill~~ such vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the mayor and confirmation by the council for the unexpired term of such member or members.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.

Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only inso-

far as the conflict exists.

Section 4. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall constitute Ordinance Number 1208.


SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE 1208

Ordinance 1208 is an ordinance of the City Of Payette, Idaho, adopted March 4, 2002. The ordinance may be descriptively known as a planning and zoning membership ordinance.

The ordinance amends sections 2.52.010 and 2.52.020 of the Payette City Code by designating the planning commission as the planning and zoning commission, it decreases the number of planning and zoning commission members from ten (10) members to seven (7) members, it allows a resident of the impact area to serve on the commission and it provides for the filling a vacancy on the commission by appointment and confirmation. Ordinance 1208 provides for severability, repealer and for publication by summary. The ordinance becomes effective immediately upon passage and publication.
