

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1221

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ADDING NEW SECTIONS 13.04.020 (A) AND 13.04.020 (B) WHICH SECTIONS PROHIBIT THE DRILLING OF DOMESTIC WATER WELLS, ALLOW SANDPOINT AND CASED WELLS OF 50' IN DEPTH FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES ONLY AND REQUIRE HOOKUPS INTO THE CITY WATER SYSTEM AFTER 60 DAYS WRITTEN NOTICE; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

Section 1. There is hereby created new sections 13;04.020 (A) and (B) of the Payette City Code, which sections shall read as follows:

13.040.020 (A) There shall be no private wells drilled within the City limits of Payette which supply domestic water needs. Sandpoint or cased wells of fifty (50') feet or less in depth for irrigation purposes may be drilled, but those wells shall comply with all Idaho Department of Water Resources requirements, shall not be connected to any structure to supply domestic needs nor connected to any structure which is hooked into the City water system.

13.040.020 (B) When any structure is located within two hundred fifty (250') feet of the City water system, after sixty (60) days written notice, the City may require the owner thereof, at the owner's expense, to hook into the City water system.

Section 2. Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and may be punished in accordance with the misdemeanor provisions of Idaho Code.


Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.


Section 4. If any portion of this ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the ordinance shall constitute Ordinance Number 1221.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
