

ORDINANCE 1239

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING ARTICLE 2.48.020 TO CLARIFY THE REQUIREMENT OF A LIBRARY BOARD MEMBER'S CITIZENSHIP WITHIN THE CITY OF PAYETTE; POSSIBLE ACTS THAT WILL AUTOMATICALLY CAUSE A VACANCY ON THE BOARD; AND ALLOW FOR BOARD MEMBER REIMBURSEMENT FOR LIBRARY RELATED EXPENSES; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO;

SECTION 1. Section 2.48.020 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.48.020 Appointment--Vacancy Filling--Compensation:

A. For the government of the public library, there shall be a Board of five (5) Library Trustees appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council from among the citizens ~~of that~~ reside and continuously maintain their residency within the City of Payette thereof at large. Such trustees shall hold their office for five (5) years from the date of appointment and until their successors are appointed. Each year, the City Council shall appoint one of its members to be a liaison to the Board, but he/she will have no voting rights.

B. Any vacancy on the board ~~All vacancies~~ shall be reported to the Mayor ~~proper Council~~ within five (5) days by its trustees, and shall be filled by appointment in the same manner as appointments are originally made. Appointments to complete an unexpired term shall be for the remainder of the term only. Vacancies automatically occur when a board member moves out of the city limits, dies or their term expires.

C. No compensation shall be paid or allowed to any Trustee ~~in any manner whatsoever-~~ other than being reimbursed for expenses incurred which were previously approved by the City Council for library related activities.

SECTION 2. Any ordinances which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

SECTION 3. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in effect and shall constitute Ordinance 1239.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
