

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1246

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, ESTABLISHING THE HOURS POLLING PLACES SHALL BE OPEN FOR CITY ELECTIONS; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1: There is hereby created a new chapter of the Payette Municipal Code which chapter shall be designated as Chapter 1.36 and which chapter shall read as follows:

Chapter 1.36

HOURS FOR POLLING PLACES

Sections: 1.36.010: HOURS FOR POLLING PLACES FOR CITY ELECTIONS.

SECTION 1.36.010: Hours of polling places for City elections. The polls for all general and special City elections shall be open from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. Mountain Time.

SECTION 2: Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only in-so-far as the conflict exists.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
