

ORDINANCE 1299

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING SECTIONS 3.12.010 and 3.12.020 OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE TO RENAME THE UTILITY ACCOUNT FUND AND ELIMINATE SEPARATE BANK ACCOUNTS; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1. Section 3.12.010 and Section 3.12.020 of the Payette Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Chapter 3.12

3.12.010 Utility Water Fund--Established And Created--Placement Or Deposit: ~~The City Treasurer shall establish and maintain a separate bank account to be known and designated as the "Utility Fund," and t~~There is created in the office of the Treasurer a special fund which shall be known and described as the "Utility Water Fund." Revenues shall be placed or deposited into said Fund, as may from time to time be directed by the Council, from which shall be paid into other funds of the City the revenues so placed, according to source, as directed by the Council.

3.12.020 Sewer Fund--Established And Created--Placement Or Deposit: ~~The City Treasurer shall establish and maintain a separate bank account to be known and designated as the "Sewer Fund," and t~~There is created in the office of the Treasurer a special fund, which shall be known and described as the "Sewer Fund," into which Fund shall be placed or deposited such revenues as may from time to time be directed by the Council and from which shall be paid such charges as may be directed by the Council.

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.


