

ORDINANCE 1318

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AMENDING SECTION 12.04.250 (D) OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE TO ALLOW APPLICATIONS FOR STANDARD CURB CUTS TO BE APPROVED BY THE CITY ENGINEER AND CITY CLERK OR THEIR DESIGNEES.; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS;

Section 1. Chapter 12.04.250 (D) of the Payette Municipal Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.04.250: SPECIFICATIONS DESIGNATED:

D. Curb Cuts: Requests for curb cuts must be made, in writing, to the City Clerk's Office Council. Curb cuts up to twenty feet (20') may be allowed on fifty foot (50') lots, and up to thirty five percent (35%) on lots above fifty feet (50'). No curb cut may be longer than thirty five feet (35'), and twenty one feet (21') of curb must be left between any two (2) curb cuts except where there are adjoining driveways. **Curb cuts in compliance with these regulations may be approved by the City Clerk and City Engineer, or their designees.** A request for any deviation in these regulations must be referred to the planning commission for approval before the council will consider such request. Every application for a building permit shall show where the curb cut will be and must have the approval of the engineer or building official

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.

Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.



SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE 1318

Ordinance 1318 is an ordinance of the City Of Payette, Idaho, adopted June 7, 2010. The ordinance may be descriptively known as Payette City Curb Cut Ordinance. Ordinance 1318 amends section 12.04.250 (D) of the Payette Municipal Code to allow applications for standard curb cuts to be approved by the City Engineer and City Clerk or by their designees. Ordinance 1318 provides a severability clause, provides for publication by summary, sets an effective date, and establishes a repealer.
