

ORDINANCE 1328

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO, REPEALING CHAPTER 5.08.120 C OF THE PAYETTE MUNICIPAL CODE; ALLOWING LIQUOR TO BE SOLD, OFFERED FOR SALE, GIVEN AWAY OR CONSUMED UPON ANY LICENSED PREMISED DURING NATIONAL OR STATEWIDE GENERAL OR PRIMARY ELECTIONS; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; ALLOWING PUBLICATION IN SUMMARY FORM; ESTABLISHING SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING A REPEALER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PAYETTE, IDAHO:

Section 1. The Payette Municipal Code is amended to hereby read as follows:

C. ~~On any other day of a national or statewide general or primary election until after the time when the polls are closed. (Ord. 1120 § 2, 1996; Ord. 998 § 1, 1990; Ord. 965 § 1, 1986; prior code § 5-5-12)~~

Section 2. This Ordinance may be published in summary form allowed by Idaho Code.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by the laws of the State of Idaho.

Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only insofar as the conflict exists.


Section 5. If any portion of this Ordinance should be found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Ordinance shall be applied to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance.
